ENRICHMENT CLUBS & WRAPAROUND CARE



AUTUMN TERM 2024

Early Birds Breakfast Club runs every day from 7.45am. All Sorts After School Club runs every day from 3.30pm.

Wraparound Care must be booked a week in advance via the Gateway Clubs section. Sessions can be booked on ad-hoc basis and must be paid for at the point of booking, unless using Tax-Free Childcare.

We accept Tax-Free Childcare vouchers as payment for Wraparound Care (Early Birds Breakfast Club and All Sorts After School Club).

Please ensure you complete a Registration Form for Wraparound Care sessions before you use the service for the first time. Registration Forms can be found on the school website, or from the school admin office.

Enrichment Clubs start 16th September and run for six weeks until half term (except Fine Art Club which only runs for 5 weeks), then run from 4th November for five weeks. There will be no enrichment clubs during the last two weeks of term. Please note some clubs only run for half a term.

Enrichment Clubs run from 3.30pm-4.30pm unless otherwise stated.

Enrichment Clubs must be booked in termly (or half termly if appropriate) blocks and paid for, in full, at the point of booking.

Payments for Enrichment Clubs are non-refundable. On a rare occasion, due to circumstances beyond our control, a club may have to be cancelled. We endeavour to give as much notice as possible, however, this may not be until the afternoon of the club. Sessions cancelled by school due to unforeseen circumstances will be rearranged or credited as appropriate.

Please make sure your child really wants to attend the clubs you choose as disruptive behaviour will not be allowed. If this happens you will be contacted and asked to collect your child. If this happens twice your child will not be allowed to continue attending the club. Please ensure you are able to collect your child promptly at the time the club finishes.

What?

Who?


10 Year 3 & 4 pupils and 10 Year 5 & 6 pupils
