Re: Class 2 Swimming Lessons

We have been given the fantastic opportunity to access a small swimming pool within the community of Kings Nympton to allow us to meet the compulsory element of the National Curriculum. All children are expected to attend every week.

The sessions will run on the following dates:

- Wednesday 5th February
- Wednesday 12th February
- Wednesday 26th February
- Wednesday 5th March
- Wednesday 12th March
- Wednesday 19th March

These sessions do not incur any fees but consent will need to be given through gateway by Wednesday 29th January 2025 and the relevant SOE3 form filled in and returned before the 6 week programme commences. Sessions will be planned, conducted and assessed by myself with support and guidance from the Swimming Teachers' Association (STA).

To maximise the opportunities in meeting objectives the class will be split into two groups. Group 1 will have their session from 11am - 11:30am and Group 2 from 11:30am - 12pm. All children will be required to wear their swimming kit under clothing which allows them to walk from the school to the Old Rectory in the village. Following the session, children will return to school where they will get changed securely. This does mean all children will require a towel, hoodie, hooded towel/robe or dressing gown to allow them to keep warm as they return to school by foot.

The kit needed will include:

- · Suitable shoes to walk to and from the pool
- Swimming kit
- Goggles (optional)
- Swim cap (optional)
- Towel, hooded towel or robe
- Spare clothing/underwear to change into
- A spare bag for wet clothing

We will not require any swimming aids or other equipment, floats will be provided as needed.

Any children who do not have the adequate kit will be asked to attend poolside with the rest of their group. Additionally, your consent is detailing that if your child is at risk by not following the instructions given to them they will be asked by a staff member to vacate the pool and not take any further part in that session.

Thank you for your co-operation with this opportunity, if you have any questions please do get in contact so they can be answered before the sessions begin.
