


RE- Who is Muslim and how do they live?

Prior Knowledge:

Children have discussed the different religions that people follow around the world. Year 2 learnt about what it is like to be Jewish in Year 1. They have learnt about different religious festivals that are celebrated throughout the year in Assemblies and talk about different religions in other lessons.
