Prior Knowledge

In KS1, children studied what 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings, what it is like to live life as a Christian ways in which people put their beliefs into action in their everyday lives and their communities, as well as what Christians believe God is like. In KS2, the children learnt what it is like for someone to follow God and about the world Jesus wanted. They learnt about the Christian Holy Trinity, the story of the end of Jesus' life and the impact of the Pentecost. They have also learnt how Jesus wanted people to live.
