Re: Somerset Cricket Schools Day – Monday 1st July 2024.

We have won tickets to attend Somerset Cricket Club to watch day 2 of the county match being played between Somerset and Warwickshire on Monday 1st July 2024. We have been allocated some free tickets for the days event and we have 5 tickets available for children in Year 5 and 6.

We do have the opportunity to travel by bus to this event. For this event, we have been able to subsidise it by using some of our PE Premium to cover part of the rising bus costs to drastically reduce the fee requested to £4.50 per child.

You will need to drop your child off at Winkleigh Primary School by 9am and we are due to travel to the county cricket ground before departing again from Somerset at 3pm. Therefore, children will need to be collected from Winkleigh Primary school at 4.30pm. They will need to bring a packed lunch, drink, sun cream, hat and coat (that will fit in their bag). Children might have the opportunity to purchase some cricket merchandise sweets, drinks or ice creams on the day so they are welcome to bring up to £10. However, this will be their responsibility to look after and is not mandatory.

We appreciate this is an extra cost. However, the opportunities to watch professional sport is limited due the cost and demand of tickets.

Please see the following information we have been sent about the event:

- Please note all bags (staff and pupils) will have to undergo a bag check before entry to the ground.
- Cans of drink, aerosol cans and glass bottles will not be allowed into the ground and will be confiscated.
- It is advised that children wear school uniform to make them more visible with other schools present on the day.
- Please be aware this is a public event where photography and filming may take place throughout the day. Images and videos may be used on the County Cricket Club, Western Storm and Cricket Foundation's website and social media channels.
- Children will be given an activity workbook that they can complete throughout the day.

If your child would like to attend please give consent with a full payment of £4.50 on the gateway by Friday 14th June 2024.
