

The children are enjoying powering Professor Klunk's Dream Machine and have received their first picture showing that the Brain has grown because of their imaginations.

In maths we are learning about place value within 100. We have been doing lots of active counting in both 1's and 10's. We have used the book 'One is a Snail, Ten is a Crab' by April Pulley Sayre and Jeff Sayre to look at number composition for both Reception and Year 1.

Until...

at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over 48 hours after their last episode	
48 hours after their last episode	
they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the nationa guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-1	
their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hour after they started antibiotics	
4 days after the rash first appeared	
5 days after the swelling started	
they've had their first treatment	
24 hours after they started taking antibiotics	
48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Families with children in Class 1 who are eligible are encouraged to apply as the funding is in addition to Universal Free School Meals!

If your circumstances have changed and you are now in receipt of one or more of the following:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

You may be eligible for pupil premium funding for Kings Nympton Primary School, which entitles your child/ren to receive Free School Meals.
