
The whole school have taken part in Design Technology week, Mr Slocombe (DT Federation Lead) taught the whole school together on Monday afternoon to start their project off.

Class 1 - Mrs Betts

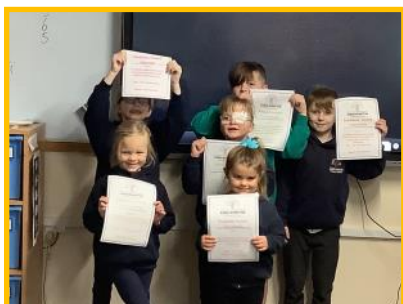
Last week we invented a story using the Gingerbread Man as our inspiration, and this week we have invented a problem for Percy the Park Keeper in *One Snowy Night*. The children are enjoying powering Professor Klunk's Dream Machine and have received their first picture showing that the Brain has grown because of their imaginations.

In maths we are learning about place value within 100. We have been doing lots of active counting in both 1's and 10's. We have used the book *'One is a Snail, Ten is a Crab'* by April Pulley Sayre and Jeff Sayre to look at number composition for both Reception and Year 1.

We have been very busy practising our Christmas play this week. If you could practise the children's lines with them it would be a great help, so that they can be script free next week. This could then enable them to concentrate on their acting because they will have memorised their lines.

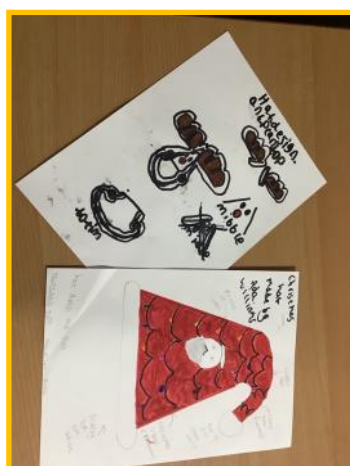

Should I keep my **child off school?**

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek

Are you entitled?

Families with children in Class 1 who are eligible are encouraged to apply as the funding is in addition to Universal Free School Meals!

If your circumstances have changed and you are now in receipt of one or more of the following:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

You may be eligible for pupil premium funding for Kings Nympton Primary School, which entitles your child/ren to receive Free School Meals.

It takes less than a minute to apply.
